



## Ends of the Earth Fund Allocation:

The primary purpose of the Ends of the Earth Fund is to support endeavors that are aligned with our Missions Convictions and are for the purpose of planting churches locally and all around the world. The ACC Missions Committee discusses and makes recommendations to the allocation of the funds being spent for this purpose.

## Ends of the Earth Budget:

The Missions Committee will discuss and approve the budget for the allocation of funds at the beginning of each calendar year. This budget will include local missions efforts for refugees/internationals, support for on-the-field-missionaries, short term trips for church members, and long term investment for church planting.

## Trip Participant Requirements:

- Member in good standing of Ashland Community Church
- Part of a Bible Fellowship Group
- Serves Faithfully

*Note: This section does not apply to Ashland Students or Children as any trips (example - NOLA) are not funded by the Ends of the Earth Fund.*

## Short-term Trip Fund Allocation:

The below list of requirements and considerations are to be reviewed by trip participants and the missions team for approval. There will be two separate types of trips of which funds can be used for.

- 1) **ACC Sponsored/Led Trips:** These are trips that are supported church wide by either ongoing relationships with churches in other countries, missionaries supported by ACC, or prospective missionary (Vision) trips. These trips align with the ACC vision and convictions for church planting among the nations. These trips will receive priority over non-ACC trips.
  - All transportation costs to and from the country are responsibility of the church member.
  - All lodging and group expenses (i.e. taxis, bus, etc) will be covered by the Ends of the Earth Fund.
  - All expenses (including travel, food, lodging, etc) will be paid in full for the trip leader.
- 2) **Non-ACC Trips:** These are trips led by trusted and vetted organizations/peoples whole align with the ACC Mission Convictions but are not necessarily led or sponsored by ACC. Examples of these types of trips could be through trusted mission agencies, SBC seminaries, or mercy ministries. The below grant structure applies the amount of funds to how much the trip aligns with church planting and discipleship. An ACC Mission Application is required for these grants and will be reviewed and determined by the ACC

Missions Committee as to which grant (if any) will be applied. Funds will only be distributed according to fund availability.

- Church-planting support: Up to \$750 grant
- Teaching/Discipleship/Evangelism: Up to \$500 grant
- Mercy ministry support: Up to \$300 grant
- Missionary care: Up to \$300 grant
- Other project-based trip: Up to \$250 grant
